PROGRAM FOR A COLLABORATIVE LAB

The daily program will consist of a *physical warm-up* open to all participants and guests, in order to start the day with movement. After a *short break*, our scientists participants will offer a “*crash course in particle physics*” to participants in order to grab the basics. After this presentation we will move on to a *choreography workshop* with a dozen of professional dancers that will be open to experiments with suggestions and ideas from guests and participants. After lunch we will have a *feedback session* on the morning workshop to prepare the next day’s choreographic session. The afternoon will be dedicated to *participants presentation of their work, collaborative research*, etc... In the evening we will offer special *GVA Sessions Events* such as films, performance, lecture and/or concerts. We will also offer an exclusive visit of CERN and have in depth encounter with CERN scientists and Arts@CERN’s organization led by Monica Bello.
